Be prepared an emergency. Complete a Family Disaster Plan. Locate items you want to take during an evacuation, including sentimental items that are irreplaceable and family photos. Post a checklist for easy reference so you don't have to think; be ready to act.

Phone - register your phone and cell phone for Alert San Diego.

Plan - Develop a family, evacuation, neighborhood plan and practice.

Prepare your home, your family, and your important documents.

Pack your to-go bag and your 72-hour preparedness kit.

### Important Documents: Gather, duplicate, and store safely off-site.

- ⑧ Insurance policies and correspondence
- ⑧ State & Federal Documents (*Birth certificates, marriage licenses, immigration documents and correspondence, passports, military papers*)
- ⑧ Tax and loan/mortgage documents
- ⑧ Stocks and bonds
- ⑧ Blueprints/floorplans
- ⑧ Identification (*Social Security card, driver's license, green card, medical ID, military*)
- ⑧ Address Book
- ⑧ Records (*Medical, Financial, Tax, Business, Bank*)
- ⑧ Insurance Information (*Home, Agriculture, Business, Auto, Medical, Life*)
- ⑧ Wills and trusts
- ⑧ Checkbooks & cash, safe deposit key
- ⑧ Important computer files downloaded to a flash drive, CD Rom, or backed up remotely
- ⑧ Photo or video recording of interior and exterior of home, contents inventory

**What to Pack:** Suggestions for what to pack in the event of an evacuation. Pack your to-go bag before you need it. Don't forget your wallet/purse and cell phone.

- ⑧ Irreplaceable items
- ⑧ Safety Devices (flashlight, batteries, first aid kit, tool kit, battery operated radio, maps)
- ⑧ Medical Devices & Medication (eye glasses, contacts, dentures, insulin pumps & materials, 2 weeks of prescription medications, CPAP, hearing aid & batteries, wheelchair/walker/crutches/canes, oxygen & carrier)
- ⑧ Family photos, videos, camera, video camera, jewelry, and mementos
- ⑧ Cell Phones, Ipods & chargers for all electronics.
- ⑧ Computer (laptop, flash drives, hard drive for PC, backup drive, power cord/charger)
- ⑧ Children (toys, books, things to occupy)
- ⑧ Infants (diapers, formula, wipes, food, extra bottles, change of clothing)
- ⑧ Change of clothes (3 days), warm jacket, uniforms, and work clothes
- ⑧ Pets (food, bowls, leashes, carrier/crate, muzzle, collars with ID, immunization records)
- ⑧ Toiletries (toothpaste, toothbrush, shampoo, soap, lotion, deodorant, razor, sunscreen, mirror, contact solution, vitamins)
- ⑧ Incidentals (wash cloth, towel, blanket)
- ⑧ Water & Snacks
