Our people

- Currently 52 volunteers
- Careers from; lawyers, architects, military, retired deputies, business owners, teachers, real estate specialist, homemakers, accountants, and just overall good people.
- Volunteers with over 11,000 hours.
- Volunteers from class of 1994
- Academy is run three times a year. (pssst..next class is in May!)



Scheduled events

- Employees to San Diego Sheriff department
- Three shifts in Poway
 - 0700-1200, 1000-1500, 1200-1700 (Monday thru Saturday)
- Two shifts in 4S
 - 0900-1300, 1200-1600 (Monday thru Saturday)
- Shifts are two people, car, radio, six days a week.
 - No weapons, no flak jackets, no sirens.
 Nonconfrontational duties to free deputies to deal with more extreme events.
- Special Sunday patrol
 - Special tour on Sunday to visit/patrol 37
 religious establishments to deter any malicious
 activities and build trust throughout the
 community.






What do we do?

- Traffic control at accidents/special events
 - DUI Checkpoints, Fall Festival, 4th of July Fireworks, Poway Days Parade Poway Rodeo, Shop with a Cop, Christmas in the Park, Halloween in the Park, Poway High graduation
- Vacation checks
 - When on vacation we will check a residence upon request. Check locked doors, remove newspapers, watch for any concerns
- Patrol areas
 - Poway is broken into 17 sectors. Drive through and check for oddities through neighborhoods, shopping centers, or any area of interest
- YANA
 - · Brief to follow
- Foot patrols
 - Deter petty theft in shopping lots by visibility and ability to radio to deputies quickly
- Handicap parking enforcement (Poway/4S)
 - Poway=\$333, 4S=\$342.50
- Graffiti reporting
 - 858-668-1234
- Honor Guard
 - Volunteer members that represent with National Ensign and Organizational Flag at community events
 - Poway parade, San Diego Sheriffs department community involvement, Special Olympics, etc.

Events from 2022

- Our ~52 volunteers committed to a total of 14,137 hours in 2022
- We patrolled a total of 915 times encompassing 50,776 miles
- We did 3462 vacation checks for 105 families that were able to enjoy their vacations
- 165 visits to YANA clients and 418 phone calls
 - We currently have 8 YANA clients
- Traffic control for 138 incidents
- Cited 105 handicap violations
- Security patrols to account for 4370 schools/churches, 3604 shopping centers, 3239 parks, 1092 industrial centers, and 1008 civic buildings





How do we recruit/Who do we recruit?

- Farmers Market
- Storefronts
- Word of mouth
- Visibility
- 50 years *or better*
- U.S. Citizen or permanent resident who has applied for citizenship
- Possess valid CA license
- Valid Medical and auto insurance
- Good Moral character. Conviction of a felony and some misdemeanors is disqualifying
- Physically and emotionally able to perform the duties of the position applied for
- Pass a two week volunteer patrol academy
- Agree to abide by all department and program rules
